MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Team 2-3 Scholarship initiative.

1. Our Recruiting Team is ecstatic to present this opportunity in order to better expose our scholarship opportunities. This initiative not only helps schools and students but also help the Georgia National Guard in the efforts to fill our ranks with highly motivated and potential leaders within our community. All Scholarships are subject to their respective school admission criteria. Each applicant must be eligible to enlist in the Georgia National Guard.
2. **Georgia Military Scholarship at North Georgia University (4 years).** Application deadline 1st Feb
 - 3.0 GPA (Cumulative), SAT 480 (Reading) 440 (Math) or ACT 20 (English) 18 (Math), demonstrate leadership potential.
3. **State Service Scholarship at Georgia Military College (2 years).** Application deadline 15th March
 - 2.5 GPA, combined 800 SAT (reading and math) or 17 ACT composite score
4. **State Service Scholarship at Mercer University (3 years).** Application deadline 15th March
 - 2.5 GPA, SAT 2100 combined or 24 ACT
5. **Army Scholarship at West Point Military Academy (4 years).** Application will be submitted after completion of Basic Combat Training and Individual Advance Training.
 - Be between 17 and 21 on July 1st of the year you would enter West Point. US Citizen. Not married. Not pregnant. Not legally responsible for support of any children. Willing to attend 1 year of Pre-school based on academics.
6. Recruiters will set a date and provide transportation for students to tour the campus of all mentioned scholarships except West Point due to location of the Campus. The students will learn firsthand of not only the school itself but also what it would take to be part of that entity. Students will have the opportunity to take as much information home and make an educated decision if this is something they would like to foresee. The recruiters will initiate

the process of enlistment at a later date upon student request and or parents consent if the student is 17 years old.
